1. Agave Americana – A classic plant of the Southwest. The perfectly symmetrical rosette of grayish green leaves grows rapidly for eight to twenty years. A tall flowering stalk shoots out of the center which signals its death. The agave dies after flowering, but by then is usually surrounded by many sucker plants, Landscaping with Native Plants of Texas and the Southwest, pg 9
